RE: 2020 – 2021 COVID-19 Campus Protocol

TO: All Enrolled Students & Employees

On behalf of President Capaci of Champion Christian College, it is our priority to ensure the safety and well-being of all who take part in our campus environment. In lieu of the COVID-19 guidelines set forth by the CDC & Arkansas Department of Health, we are both aware of the disbursed information as well as in compliance to promote such on campus in the following ways:

1. **Hand sanitizer** will be available on campus in multiple locations and all participants are expected to use it frequently for all campus activities.
2. **Disposable gloves** will be available if needed; campus participants are encouraged to bring their own gloves if feasible.
3. **Social distancing** is expected; modified spacing will be arranged in the classrooms for instruction and any on-campus gatherings.
4. All campus participants are to have a **face mask** in his or her possession while on campus at any time. Although initially it is not required to wear a face mask, this is to ensure that a face mask is available to wear if needed at an unforeseen time. Moreover, all campus participants are welcome to wear face masks regardless if so desired.

Please note that Champion Christian College is in on ongoing working partnership with the UAMS College of Public Health for Higher Education. This partnership encompasses multiple Colleges and Universities across the State of Arkansas and exists for the purpose of establishing a communication network of contact tracing for campus health. *Contact Tracing* is the process of identifying any one person (A) who may have come in contact with another person (B) with a known case of an infectious disease and then working with person (A) to interrupt any potential disease transmission.

In light of contact tracing, Champion Christian College will be adjusting the Fall 2020 semester schedule in regards to Thanksgiving and Christmas breaks. Thus, students will be expected to leave campus during Thanksgiving Break and not return until the Spring 2021 semester. The only exception to such will be students residing in campus housing that are

Additionally, all enrolled students and employees of Champion Christian College will be issued an “*Acknowledgement & Pledge Agreement*.” This is a document that is required to be signed and dated by the aforementioned said parties. The purpose is to ensure a measure of unilateral compliance from all campus participants that better ensures a safe, clean campus-wide environment. The Acknowledgement and Pledge Agreement must be signed and dated before the first day of classes begins for students and employees.

Chapel services are ready to kick off with incredible guest speakers. Both the Capachi’s Café and the Champion Community Center will be open for extended hours, and so much more to come!
