



<p>ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP</p>	<p>APPLICATION DEADLINE: To ensure a student receive this, he/she should apply by August 31st of each calendar year. This discount is automatically applied to students account with proof of eligibility.</p> <p>ELIGIBILITY: Entering freshman must have an ACT score of 19 or SAT of 990, a minimum GPA of 3.0 on the high school transcripts. The student <i>must enroll in 15 credit hours</i> in order to qualify for this scholarship. Likewise, returning students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, have passed a minimum of 12 credit hours in the previous semester, and be enrolled in 15 credit hours in order to qualify for this scholarship.</p> <p>SCOPE: This will be awarded to qualifying students for the 2020/21 school year and will be applied to their school bill.</p> <p>RENEWABILITY: A student must maintain a 3.0 GPA each semester. Amount of award is subject to change depending on performance. Discounts awarded in the Fall semester are only awarded again in the Spring semester if the GPA criteria is satisfied. Furthermore, there will be no promotions to higher award level within an academic year. For example, if a student qualified for a Bronze scholarship in the Fall semester with a 3.0 GPA at \$500 and finished the semester with a cumulative GPA of 3.5, he or she would not receive award for the Silver amount at \$750 for the Spring semester immediately following. Therefore, the discount amount with which a student starts the academic year (Fall & Spring Semesters) is the same amount the student will continue to receive during that particular academic year.</p> <p>AWARD (DISCOUNT) RANGE: <i>Bronze Scholarship</i> - GPA range is 3.0 - 3.49 and the award is \$1,000 each academic year or \$500 each semester. <i>Silver Scholarship</i> - GPA range is 3.5 - 3.74 and the award is \$1,500 per academic year or \$750 per semester. <i>Gold Scholarship</i> - GPA range is 3.75 - 4.0 and the award is \$2,500 per academic year or \$1,250 each semester.</p>
<p>FULL-TIME CHRISTIAN SERVICE</p>	<p>APPLICATION DEADLINE: This is given out to any students eligible. The deadline to apply for the fall semester is August 1 of each calendar year.</p> <p>ELIGIBILITY: Students qualify for a discount of up to \$500.00 each semester if their parent, who is considered the Head of Household, receives their primary income from serving in the ministry full-time.</p> <p>CRITERIA: Parent or legal guardian must be employed full-time in church ministry.</p> <p>PURPOSE: This is designed to pay for \$500 for each semester at Champion Christian College.</p> <p>SCOPE: This discount will be awarded to qualifying students for the 2019/20 school year and will be applied to their school bill.</p> <p>RENEWABILITY: A student may apply once upon entrance to Champion Christian College.</p>
<p>PRESIDENTIAL</p>	<p>APPLICATION DEADLINE: To ensure a student receive this discount, he/she should apply by August 1st of each calendar year. This discount is automatically applied to students account with proof of eligibility.</p> <p>ELIGIBILITY: Students who are members of a church that financially supports Champion Christian College qualify for a discount of up to \$500 for the fall semester only. This award provides a \$250 discount for a church's \$50 monthly support amount and a \$500 per semester discount for a \$100 monthly support amount.</p> <p>SCOPE: This discount will be awarded to qualifying students for the 2020/21 school year and will be applied to their school bill. For students to receive this benefit, their church must have supported Champion Christian College for a minimum of six months prior to the student's enrollment. * (Pastors interested in making this scholarship available to their students need to contact the business office at Champion Christian College for complete details.)</p> <p>CRITERIA: For students to receive this benefit, their church must have supported Champion Christian College for a minimum of six months prior to the student's enrollment. * (Pastors interested in making this discount available to their students need to contact the business office at Champion Christian College for complete details.)</p> <p>RENEWABILITY: Students can apply each academic year as long as the participating church continues financially supporting Champion Christian College.</p> <p>RANGE: This provides a \$250 discount to student's tuition for a church's \$50 monthly support amount and a \$500 per semester discount for a \$100 monthly support amount</p>

<p>LEADERSHIP PARTICIPATION DISCOUNT</p>	<p>APPLICATION DEADLINE: To ensure a student receive this award, he/she should apply by August 1st of each calendar year. This is automatically applied to students account with proof of eligibility.</p> <p>ELIGIBILITY: All students involved in a role of leadership as assigned by the administration are able to receive this discount.</p> <p>SCOPE: Students accepted as a member of a leadership role and/or a function that contributes to the services of Champion Christian College and meet the following criteria are eligible for a \$1,200 discount on tuition.</p> <p>CRITERIA: The requirements are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Graduation from high school, graduation from homeschool, or achievement of GED certificate at time of initial enrollment • Maintain a 2.5 GPA • Limited number of class absences • Continuing recipients must be current on their school bill. • The student must maintain the position throughout the entire semester.
<p>VETERANS BENEFITS</p>	<p>Champion accepts VA tuition assistance programs. Champion has been approved by the State Approving Agency for Veterans Training for V.A. recipient status. Qualifying veterans should complete the application for V.A. education benefits by filing V.A. form 22-1990 with the V.A. Regional Office: P.O. Box 8888; Muskogee, OK 74402-8888</p>
<p>FEDERAL FINANCIAL AID</p>	<p>Champion Christian College accepts Federal Student Aid. Visit fafsa.ed.gov to apply for Federal Student Aid and get more information on eligibility.</p> <p>If you have already filed a FAFSA, do not complete another application. If you did not include the Federal School Code for Champion Christian College on the FAFSA you submitted, access the FAFSA already completed and add school code 042761 for Champion Christian College.</p> <p>In order to complete a FAFSA, the student and a parent must use a unique Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID). To create your own unique FSA ID, please go to https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch.</p> <p>You will need prior tax and other financial information for you (and your parents) to complete the FAFSA. We highly recommend using the IRS Data Retrieval function in the FAFSA to retrieve unaltered student and parent tax data from the IRS to populate the appropriate FAFSA fields. Doing so provides a more accurate result and reduces the additional documents required to process the file when it arrives at the college.</p> <p>Following completion and submission of your FAFSA, the financial aid office should receive your results in approximately 7-10 business days.</p>
<p>ARKANSAS FINANCIAL AID</p>	<p>In Addition, Champion is recognized by the ADHE and accepts ADHE scholarships. These scholarships can be viewed at https://scholarships.adhe.edu</p>
<p>CAMPUS WORK STUDY</p>	<p>Max Available: \$3,000 per year. This program is designed for students who have additional income needs which cannot be met by other financial sources. Eligibility is determined by financial need, class schedule, and academic progress. The work study jobs are mostly on campus and according to availability of funds.</p> <p>To apply for the work study program, please complete the online work-study application from Jeff Manthe's Office and return to President Capaci's Office.</p>
<p>THE KATRINA ROBERTSON SERVICE AWARD SCHOLARSHIP</p>	<p>The Katrina Robertson Service Award Scholarship was created in honor of Katrina Robertson by her husband, Dr. Shane A. Robertson. Katrina Robertson's Christ-like passion, unconditional love and unselfish service towards others in her local community is an incredible example of fulfilling the Great Commandment (Mark 12:28-31). This scholarship is available to students seeking a degree at Champion Christian College who actively serve others.</p> <p>RANGE: Two scholarships, valued at \$1000 per student (\$500 per semester), will be awarded to two full-time students at Champion Christian College to be used towards tuition and fees for the academic calendar year 2021-2022.</p> <p>ELIGIBILITY: Any full-time student enrolled at Champion Christian College (min. 12 credit hours).</p> <p>CRITERIA: The requirements are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To maintain the scholarship for second semester, student must maintain a 2.5 GPA in the fall semester. • To maintain the scholarship, student must be seeking a degree in a program offered by Champion Christian College. • A special committee selected by Dr. Shane and Katrina Robertson will review all applications and select the award based on criteria. The decision of that committee is final. In the event the student selected declines the initial award for any reason, the committee may, at its discretion, select a back-up winner. • Information on the application will be used to contact the winner. • CCC and the Robertson family will not be responsible for misinformation provided on the application.
